# **Board Meeting Minutes April 2018**

### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

#### **RFPORTS**

- 7. Should infield practice be eliminated between innings
- 8. No shows

Bobby provided a handout and all rules changes were discussed and approved.

Sponsorship: Ken Beals reported he is calling and visiting sponsors and has two new names to call.

Communications: The website is fine and there have been several nice articles written in Saddlebrooke papers by Mark and we have gotten several new players as a result of the articles.

### Old Business:

George reported that sign-ups for the Spring season were slow in coming but should have enough players for 3 teams in Community for Monday and Friday, 2 teams in Recreation, and 2 teams for Competitive. We are uncertain at this point about Coyote.
